DAY 1 DEPARTURE FROM US

Arrive in Paris and transfer to Chateau Montvillargene. Optional gourmet dinner at the Chateau. Overnight

DAY 3 MONTVILLARGENNE – ROUEN.

After Breakfast depart to Rouen with stop to visit Chateau de La Roche-Guyon – Rommel's Headquarters. Welcome dinner in Rouen and overnight.

DAY 4 ROUEN – CAEN

Check in at your hotel and in the afternoon visit the WWII Caen's Memorial. Dinner and overnight.

DAY 5 CAEN NORMANDY VISIT

Sainte-Mere-Eglise - Germany Cemetery - Utah Beach - Pointe du Hoc Bayeux/ Commonwealth Cemetery. Dinner on own and overnight.

DAY 6 CAEN NORMANDY VISIT

Omaha Beach - American Cemetery - Gold, Juno & Sword Beaches. Other Battle Sites. Dinner and overnight.

DAY 7 CAEN - SAINT-MALO VISIT MONT ST MICHEL

Dinner on own and overnight.

DAY 8 ST MALO – PARIS

On the way stop for lunch in Chartres with visit of the Cathedral. Travel to Paris. Dinner on own and overnight.

DAY 9 PARIS HALF DAY SIGHTSEEING

Afternoon free for shopping Farewell Dinner cruise. Overnight
